A DEFINITIONS

Develop	To make your ideas grow or change into a more advanced, larger, or stronger body of work.
Refine	To make something better, removing unwanted areas and to improve by making small changes.
Record	To produce a piece of evidence, a drawing or photograph for later reference.
Experiment	Trial different media and compositions, test, develop and discover.
Context	The circumstances that form the setting for an event, statement, or idea. A piece of text that explains meaning.
Visual element	The Visual Elements of line, shape, tone, colour, pattern, texture and form are the building blocks of composition in art.
Analysis	A detailed examination of the elements or structure of something in order to gain a better understanding.
Critical	To be able to express and analyse the merits and faults of a piece of work.
